Updates to Our Inclement Weather Closing Policy:

The Woods Memorial Library will follow the Quabbin Regional School District (QRSD) closure policy during periods of inclement weather.

- If the QRSD cancels or closes school due to inclement weather, the library will also be closed.
- If the QRSD delays opening by two hours on a Wednesday or Thursday when the library normally opens at 10 a.m., the library will open at 12 p.m.
- If the QRSD delays opening by two hours on a Tuesday or Friday when the library normally opens at 2 p.m., the library will open at 2 p.m.
- During weekends or summer, any weather-related emergency closings or delayed openings will be made at the discretion of the Director, in collaboration with the Board of Trustees.

Announcements regarding closings or delayed openings will be made on the library website, the library's Facebook page, and our answering machine message.

The primary factor of any decision made will be the safety of the staff and library patrons.

Coloring Club with Tea Wednesdays at 6:30 p.m. (Ongoing Jan. - Mar.)


