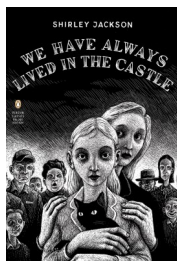

Our Holiday Closing Procedure has changed!

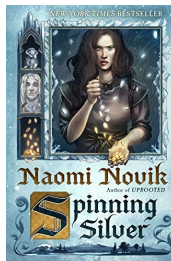

Spirit Communication with Jeff Belanger

Wednesday, October 9 at 6:30 p.m.

For over 20 years, Jeff Belanger has been exploring the unexplained. He seeks out history, folklore, ghosts, monsters, and legends all over the world and in your backyard. He's the award-winning, Emmy-nominated host, writer, and producer of the New England Legends series on PBS and Amazon Prime, and is the author of over a dozen books on the unexplained. He also hosts the popular weekly podcast *New England Legends*.



This multi-media program, based on his book, *Communicating with the Dead*, explores the history of spirit communication from the Fox Sisters in the earliest days of the Spiritualist movement, to devices such as the Ouija Board and Dowsing Rods, and on to using electronic devices to try and communicate with the other side. You'll explore the history, see and hear the evidence, and maybe catch a glimpse of what's beyond the grave. A Q&A and book signing will follow the program.
